

Germany Mission Trip 2022

July 5-13, 2022

Who is Eligible to Go?

Students who are active at Wallace and are currently in the 10-12th grade. We will open trip to active 9th grade students if all the spots do not fill up by the sign-up/deposit deadline.

How Many People are Going?

We have a maximum capacity of 12 students and 4 adult leaders that will be able to go.

Who Are the Adult Leaders Going?

The trip leader is Pastor Jarred Morgan. Jen Morgan will also be joining as an adult leader. We are currently still in the process of finalizing the other two adult leaders.

Where in Germany Will They Be Serving and Who Are We Partnering With?

Students will primarily be serving in Cologne, Germany with our partners, Michael and Ginger DeBusk. The DeBusks are IMB Missionaries who are currently working to reach the "T-People" in Germany.

What Exactly Will the Team Be Doing in Germany?

The Team will be involved in several different outreach opportunities. These include, but are not limited to: Neighborhood blitzes, henna storying, homeless ministry, face painting outreach, cultural exchange with students at school, refugee camp ministry, and more.

What Are the Covid Restrictions/Requirements?

Due to Germany's strict restrictions for those who are unvaccinated, we are requiring all team members to be fully vaccinated to go on this trip.

What Is the Cost of the Trip?

The total cost that will be due will be \$1500. This includes all ground fees and flights.

When is the Deadline to Sign-Up?

All students and leaders need to sign up and pay a *\$100 deposit by January 5th* at the latest. After the 5th, we will see if there are any open spots before opening the trip up to the 9th grade class.

Other Important Info:

- You need to apply for a passport ASAP. The DeBusks said that due to delays, it could take up to 6 months to arrive.
- There will be required trainings and meetings leading up to the trip. These dates/times will be announced in January once we have our team formed.
