ONE WKND FAQ

WHAT IS ONE WKND?

ONE WKND is a time for our students to grow closer to both God and each other through worship sessions, bible study, meals, games, and other activities. Adult leaders in our church will be serving as host homes and bible study leaders for our students throughout the weekend. Host Homes will be organized by grade and gender. A complete breakdown of host homes and leaders is provided in this packet.

WHERE IS ONE WKND?

Worship sessions will be held at Wallace Memorial Baptist Church (701 Merchant Drive 37912). Host Homes are located throughout the city. A list of host home addresses will be available at check-in.

WHEN IS ONE WKND?

Students will be dropped off with luggage at Wallace on Friday November 21st @ 7PM for registration. They will need to be picked up at our Wallace Campus (701 Merchant Dr. 37912) on Sunday November 23rd @ Noon.

WHAT IS THE COST?

The cost for members and regular attenders is \$100/student New guests and siblings \$75. There is no cost for host homes and leaders. **Students can sign up at www.wallacestudents.com/onewknd**

WHAT DO STUDENTS NEED TO BRING?

Bible. Pen. Notebook. Pillow. Sleeping Bag/Air Mattress. Towel. Toiletries. Snacks/Drinks (optional) Please DO NOT send snacks with nuts/peanut butter. We will all wear our WKND United shirts to church on Sunday morning.

Please DO NOT BRING any electronics that will be distracting, inappropriate clothing/memorabilia, weapons/fireworks of any kind, or alcohol/drugs.

WHAT WILL THEY EAT?

Students need to have eaten dinner before arriving on Friday Night. We will provide a snack bar when students arrive Friday Evening. Host homes will provide breakfast on Saturday. Lunch & dinner will be in the atrium at Wallace on Saturday. Sunday morning will be breakfast in the student center during connect.

ONE WKND FAQ (cont.)

WHAT ABOUT MEDICATIONS/FOOD ALLERGIES?

Please provide a detailed schedule of times/dosages/information of medication at registration. If a student has a food allergy, please list that in that designated place on the online registration form as well.

All student participants need to fill out an online 2025 Wallace Students Release Form. If you have already filled out a 2025 Wallace Students form, you do not need to fill out another one (it is good for the entire year of 2025).

CAN STUDENTS ARRIVE LATE ON FRIDAY NIGHT/SATURDAY MORNING?

Yes. We understand that there may be activities (like football/band) happening on Friday nights that students have a prior commitment. We encourage students to still participate in the weekend and just arrive late on Friday or get dropped off at their host home on Saturday morning. We just ask that you make us aware of your plans ahead of time.

WHAT IF STUDENTS NEED TO LEAVE AND COME BACK?

For students to get the full experience of the weekend, we do not encourage students to leave during the weekend unless it is an activity with a time conflict that could not be resolved. If students are leaving at any point during the weekend, a parent/guardian will need to turn in a signed **Time Away Form** at registration!

CAN STUDENTS DRIVE THEMSELVES DURING THE WEEKEND?

Students may drive themselves to the church on Friday night, but we ask that students who drive to leave their cars at the church and ride with our group leaders and host home adults throughout the weekend. Any student with special circumstances who needs to drive during the weekend for any reason needs to fill out a special attention form at check-in.

STUDENTS CANNOT DRIVE OTHER STUDENTS UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.
