WKND UNITED STUDENT FAQ SHEET

What is WKND United?

WKND United is a time for our students to grow closer to both God and each other through worship sessions, small group bible study, service projects, meals, games, and other activities. Adult leaders in our church will be serving as host homes and bible study leaders for our students throughout the weekend. Host Homes will be organized by grade and gender. A complete breakdown of host homes and leaders is provided in this packet. Addresses and phone numbers of host homes and leaders will be available upon request. All of our leaders and host homes will be completing a background check to help ensure the safety of all our students.

Where is WKND United?

Worship sessions will be held at Wallace Memorial Baptist Church (701 Merchant Drive 37912). Host Homes are located throughout the city. Students also will be serving together in various locations throughout the city on Saturday afternoon. A list of host home addresses will be available at check-in.

When is WKND United?

Students will be dropped off with luggage at Wallace on Friday November 22nd at 7PM for registration. They will need to be picked up at our Wallace Campus (701 Merchant Dr. 37912) on Sunday November 24th at Noon.

What is the Cost?

The cost for members and regular attenders is \$50 on sign up launch night (October 2nd) until Midnight. Price will go up to \$60 from October 3rd until October 30th. The cost will increase to \$75 on October 31st. New guests and siblings will remain at \$50. There is no cost for host homes and leaders. **You can sign up at wallacestudents.com/wkndunited.**

What Do Students Need to Bring?

Bible, Pen, Notebook, Pillow, Sleeping Bag or Air Mattress, Modest Sleepwear, Towel, and Toiletries. Snacks/Drinks for homes are optional but not required. Due to many students who have severe nut allergies, we ask that you do not send snacks with nuts/peanut butter. We will all wear our WKND United shirts to church on Sunday morning (students will receive these at their host homes on Saturday night). Please do not bring electronics that will be distracting, inappropriate clothing/memorabilia, weapons/fireworks of any kind, or alcohol/drugs. ***We will have a DARK-MODE THEME for our silent disco on Saturday Night – pack your appropriate all-black clothing attire.***

What Will They Eat?

Students need to have eaten dinner before arriving on Friday Night. We will provide dessert when students arrive Friday Evening. Host homes will provide breakfast/lunch on Saturday and breakfast on Sunday. We will be having Chick Fil A as a large group at Wallace on Saturday Night .

What About Medications/Food Allergies?

Please provide a detailed schedule of times/dosages/information of medication at registration. If a student has a food allergy, please list that in that designated place on the online registration form as well. All student participants need to fill out an online 2024 Wallace Students Release Form. If you have already filled out a 2024 Wallace Students form, you do not need to fill out another one (it is good for the entire year of 2024).

Can students arrive late on Friday or Saturday morning if they have an activity on Friday night?

Yes. We understand that there may be activities (like football/band) happening on Friday nights that students have a prior commitment. We encourage students to still participate in the weekend and just arrive late on Friday or get dropped off at their host home on Saturday morning. We just ask that you make us aware of your plans ahead of time.

What If Students Need to Leave for an Event/Activity and Come Back?

In order for students to get the full experience of the weekend, we do not encourage students to leave during the weekend unless it is an activity with a time conflict that could not be resolved. If students are leaving at any point during the weekend, a parent/guardian will need to turn in a signed Time Away Form at registration.

Can Students Drive Themselves During the Weekend?

Students may drive themselves to the church on Friday night, but we ask that students who drive to leave their cars at the church and ride with our group leaders and host home adults throughout the weekend. Any student with special circumstances who needs to drive during the weekend for any reason needs to fill out a special attention form at check-in. Students cannot drive other students unless it is their immediate family or prior approval has been given.

Will Students Be Staying at Host Homes with Other Churches?

Students need to stay in the host home with the church they registered to attend with. This applies as well to all Saturday activities, including service projects.
